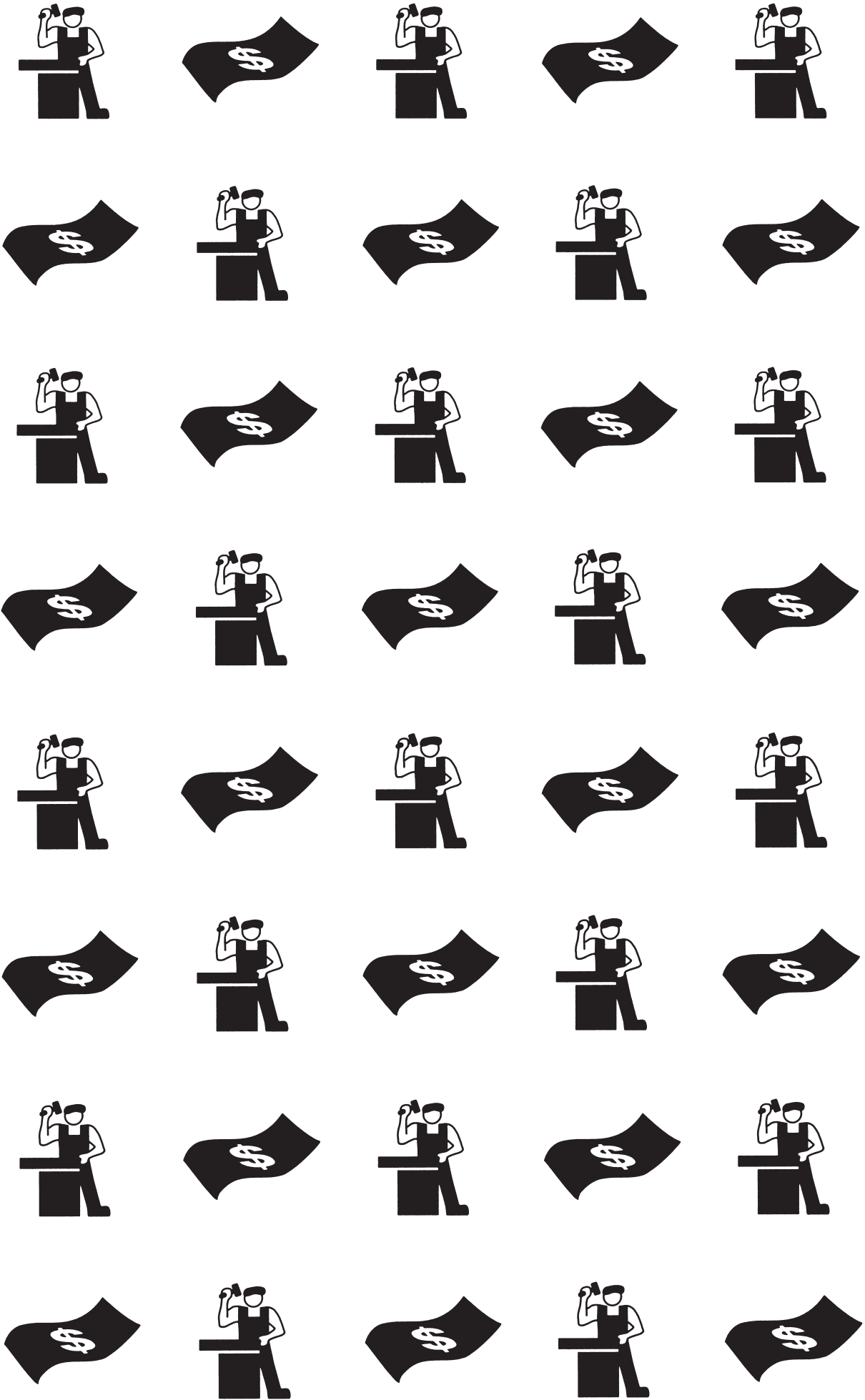

FINANCE & LABOR

Part one of this section presents statistics on the financial institutions on Maui. Part two includes figures for Maui County's labor force.

The civilian labor force for 2022 was 87,250 and the number of employed was 84,250. The unemployment rate decreased from 7.7% to 3.5% between 2021 and 2022.

Data for this section came from many sources, including the Hawai'i State Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism and the Hawai'i Department of Industrial Labor and Relations.
